

Security+ Certified Professional Certification Program

Security+ is a CompTIA vendor-neutral certification that measures the technical knowledge of networking professionals in the IT industry. The Security+ certification is targeted for candidates with at least two years on-the-job networking experience with an emphasis on security.

Earning a CompTIA Security+ certification demonstrates proof of knowledge and expertise in security topics, such as communication security, infrastructure security, cryptography, access control, authentication, external attack and operational and organization security. Companies in every industry, government agencies, and companies that do government contract work benefit from Security+. Increasingly, government agencies and contractors in the U.S. are having to comply with new laws or directives that require them to demonstrate that they have policies and skilled workers in place to help counteract the risk of confidential information getting into criminal hands.

Students learn how to successfully configure, execute, construct, and troubleshoot network security to ensure the threat of viruses is minimized or negated. This course prepares candidates for CompTIA Security+ Exam.
