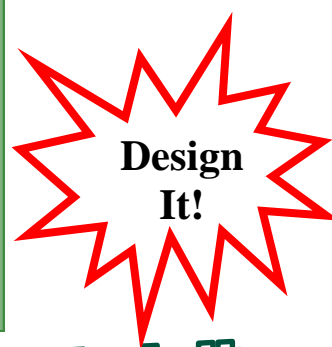
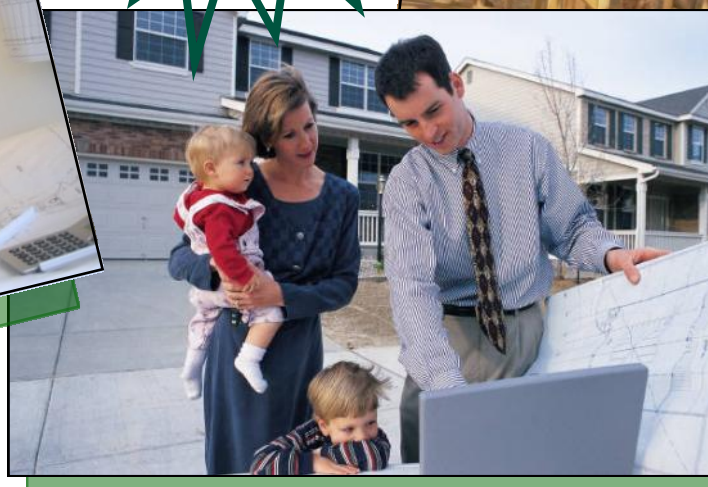

This is an advanced course in Chief Architect X1, a computer modeling program for residential construction. This course will focus on getting models ready for presentation and using them to produce drawings. Universal design options that make the home accessible to all, including the disabled and the elderly will be addressed. A portion of each class will be devoted to working through problems that students bring to the class from the field. Students will need to be familiar with Chief Architect X1 and have access to the program during the week for homework. ## How Do I Register for Classes?
