

Network+ Certified Professional Certification Program

Network+ is a CompTIA vendor-neutral certification that measures the technical knowledge of networking professionals in the IT industry. The Network+ certification is targeted for candidates with at least 9 months of experience in network support and administration. It requires experience and knowledge in the areas of network administration, support, implementation and troubleshooting.

Network+ has been accepted by the leading networking vendors, and is included in many of their training curricula. Earning the Network+ certification means that the candidate possesses the knowledge needed to configure and operate a variety of networking products. Job responsibilities include basic network administration, support, implementation and troubleshooting.

The course provides the essentials of networking, as well as in-depth study of TCP/IP, the communication language of networks and the Internet. The course covers a wide range of vendor and product-neutral networking technologies. This course prepares candidates for CompTIA Network+ Exam.

- Networking fundamentals
- The OSI model
- Overview of major network operating systems
- TCP/IP fundamentals
- TCP/IP utilities
